

SPCA Student Budget Policy Addendum:

- Pre-approval required for purchasing over \$100: please indicate student name, grade and educational justification/Master Agreement connection in an email to your teacher.
- CPR/First Aid/Babysitting courses will be approved only if aligned with class on MA and if offered through a certified program.
- Each student is allowed to spend up to \$250/semester (\$50 per month) on field excursions outside of SPCA.
 - o Amusement parks WILL NOT be reimbursed.
 - o All excursions MUST take place during the school year.
- PE or Enrichment activities for a single (1) day are limited to \$50.
- iFly can only be reimbursed if attended as a school-led STEM field excursion.
- Event Tickets will be reimbursed up to \$50 per event/per student to non-professional athletics, visual and performing arts events. If student is in grades 9-12, event must align with a course on their Master Agreement.
- Students cannot use more than 50% (\$130/month) of their budgets on PE or Enrichment with a community partner or for reimbursement.
 - Students who are at or above grade level on state identified assessments may use up to \$180/ month on PE or Enrichment. This is determined by:
 - Scoring in the green or blue for the 2023 Caaspp in both ELA and Math.
 - Scoring above 60% in Fall and Winter MAP (3-11) in both ELA and Math
 - Meeting benchmark on DIBELS and MClass (K-2)
 - Students who are below grade level on state identified assessments may use up to \$180/month on PE or Enrichment if they complete the required school provided interventions.
- Students cannot exceed \$200 monthly to a single vendor. Exceptions possible for Math/ELA supports as indicated through MAP or DIBELS scores.
- Meal Kits will not be reimbursed (i.e. Blue Apron, Hello Fresh, Home Chef, etc.).

*These addendums are to be used in conjunction with the Student Budget Policy located in the PCI Parent-Student handbook. All budget approvals are at the discretion of the credentialed teacher and administration.
