Also please remember that **according to CDPH**, **all public-school students taking classes indoors are mandated to wear a mask to use their instructional funds for services through either a Purchase Order or Reimbursement. By signing your Reimbursement Form, you are stating that you are adhering to these guidelines.** Any unused funds from semester 1 will roll over to semester 2.
