

SPCA Student Budget FAQs

Q: How much of my student's budget can be used on Legos?

A: Legos are limited to \$50 per school year, including off brand Legos. Just a reminder that Legos that are purchased with school funds must be kept separate from personal Legos and returned to the school once the student is finished using them or you disenroll from Sutter Peak.

Q: How much of my student's budget can be used on robots or robotic kits?

A: Robots and robotic kits are limited to \$100 per year.

Q: How much of my student's budget can be used on a backpack?

A: Backpacks should be limited to \$50.

Q: Can High School students get reimbursed for materials for Community College classes?

A: Yes, if the materials are required for the class. A syllabus from the class indicating the required materials must be submitted with the reimbursement request.

Q: Can I spend student funds on a globe?

A: Yes, but it must be a standard globe (not light up or talking) and must be less than \$50.

Q: Can I submit Venmo, PayPal, Bank or Credit Card receipts as proof of purchase or payment?

A: No. All receipts must contain all required information as outlined on the reimbursement request form which includes form of payment.

Q: Can I get reimbursed for items from Amazon?

A: Yes.
